AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 3, SIGN ORDINANCE, SECTION 3-36, SUBSECTION (c) MULTIPLE MESSAGE SIGNS, SUBPARAGRAPH (10), SO AS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MULTIPLE MESSAGE SIGNS ALLOWED FROM 35 TO 50.

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN HEREBY ORDAIN and amend the code of ordinances for the City of Dublin, Georgia as follows:

SECTION ONE

Subparagraph (10) of Subsection (c) of Section 3-36 of the code of ordinances which currently reads:

“The total number of multiple-message signs (including multiple-message billboards) within the City of Dublin shall be limited to thirty-five (35) signs.”

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

“The total number of multiple-message signs (including multiple-message billboards) within the City of Dublin shall be limited to fifty (50) signs.”

SECTION TWO


This Ordinance shall become effective at 12:00 noon on the fifth day after adoption.
