A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO OBTAIN EDA PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FACILITIES DISASTER GRANT FUNDS TO ASSIST IN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO GEORGIA HIGHWAY 257 RAIL SERVED SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin supports sound economic development initiatives within the City of Dublin, realizing that such activity is in the best interest of the City of Dublin, Laurens County and the Heart of Georgia Altamaha Region, and resulting in the creation of new jobs and increased capital investment in and around Dublin-Laurens County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has recognized the need for sewer facilities at the Georgia Highway 257 Rail Served Site; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has identified a lack of sufficient funds to address the rehabilitation of existing sewer infrastructure and extension to the Georgia Highway 257 Rail Served Site; and

WHEREAS, City of Dublin and Economic Development Administration (EDA) Public Works and Economic Development Facilities Disaster funds are sufficient to address this need; and


WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has agreed apply for EDA Public Works and Economic Development Facilities Disaster funds to address this need; and

WHEREAS, the Dublin-Laurens County Development Authority has agreed to be a co-applicant for EDA Public Works and Economic Development Facilities Disaster funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin and Dublin-Laurens County Development Authority has requested that the staff of the Heart of Georgia Altamaha Regional Commission assist in the preparation of the EDA application and the administration of the EDA project, if awarded.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Dublin will apply to EDA for Public Works and Economic Development Facilities Disaster funds to address the identified needs and will accept EDA funding if awarded.
