

**RESOLUTION
#20-24**

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO DIRECT AND APPROVE THE ASSESSMENT, LEVY, AND COLLECTION OF THE 2020 CITY OF DUBLIN FINAL TAX MILLAGE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN; TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE CITY TREASURER AND CITY TAX MARSHALL TO ASSESS, LEVY, AND COLLECT SAID AD VALOREM TAXES; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Tax Officials of the City of Dublin, Georgia have made a final report and recommendation to this body as required by the Code of the City of Dublin, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, this report was based upon the final **2020** Laurens County Tax Digest; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Dublin, Georgia, authorizes the body to assess, levy, and collect ad valorem taxes on all property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of said City, and upon all goods, chattels, monies and choses in action where the owner resides within the corporate limits of said City, which are subject to taxation by the laws of this State, and upon banking, insurance, and other capital employed therein and upon any and all other things not mentioned herein upon which ad valorem taxes are usually paid; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the final millage rate for the year **2020-2021** now be determined by this body so as to ensure the collection of revenue with which to operate the City of Dublin, Georgia.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED based on the foregoing, by this body that the final ad valorem tax millage assessed, levied, and collected for the City of Dublin, Georgia for the fiscal year **2020-2021**, be as follows, to wit:

An ad valorem tax of **6.519** mills for the support of the City of Dublin, Georgia, for general governmental functions of the City of Dublin on all property, real and personal within the corporate limits of said City, which are subject to taxation by the laws of the State; and upon banking, insurance and other capital employed therein and upon any and all things not mentioned herein upon which ad valorem taxes are usually paid.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer and City Tax Marshall are hereby authorized and directed to assess, levy, and collect said taxes as provided herein and as required by law and to take such actions as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution on behalf of the City of Dublin; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any Ordinance or Resolution or motions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby amended.

THIS RESOLUTION so adopted at the meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Dublin, Georgia on this the **1st** day of **October, 2020** by a vote of (7) FOR and (0) AGAINST.
