REQUEST FOR CITY OF DUBLIN BLACK HISTORY BANNER GUIDELINES

- 1. Individuals must be retired or out of office for at least five years before being eligible to apply for banner. Potential honorees may be living or deceased.
- 2. The individual must be a visionary and dedicated leader who has made a significant contribution to the African American community through their profession or participation in the City of Dublin.
- 3. Strong consideration will be given to applicants who have contributed to African American history in the City of Dublin by being a trailblazer in their profession or community or within the fields of diversity, inclusion, civil rights, and social justice.
- 4. Completion of application request for Black History Banner.
- 5. Submit along with application a Nomination Letter that includes:
 - a. A biography of the nominee which could include birth date and location, educational background, and a summary of their life history;
 - b. Description of the nominee's work in the area of social justice and/ or civic accomplishment;
 - c. Example(s) of instances when the nominee has been a defining force in this area;
 - d. Challenges that the nominee has overcome to work in the field of social justice and/or civic accomplishment or acted as an instrument for social justice and/or civic accomplishment;
 - e. List any related awards or recommendations that the nominee has received;
 - f. A high-resolution photo of the nominee must be included. (5MB image preferred)
- 6. Banners are \$100 per banner and will be displayed for 5 years. Maximum of 2 banners allowed if space permits.
- 7. After 5 years, an additional \$100 per banner will need to be paid to continue displaying each banner. (max of 2 banners per honoree)
- 8. The exact placement of the banners in the downtown business district is not guaranteed. Banners be placed in no particular order and placement is not a reflection of achievement.
- 9. Applications, nomination letters, and a non-refundable application fee of \$50 qualify as a complete packet. *The completed packet must be received by end of business on July 11, 2025.*

CITY OF DUBLIN BLACK HISTORY BANNER SCORING GUIDELINES (40 total points available)

Nomination Letter- 30 points

The nomination letter should highlight the reason why the nominee should be honored with a banner in Downtown Dublin.

• Biography - 5 points

Includes the nominee's birthdate and location, educational background, and a summary of their life history.

Social Accomplishments - 5 points

Description of the nominee's work in the area of social justice and/or civic accomplishment

Contribution - 10 points

Challenges the nominee has overcome to work in the field of social justice and/or civic accomplishment or acted as an instrument for social justice and/or civic accomplishment

• Community engagement - 5 points

Example(s) of instances when the nominee has been a defining force in this area

Awards- 5 points

Related awards or recommendations that the nominee has received

Completed application request for Black History Banner and a high-resolution photo - 10 points

Each section has a scoring range of 0-5. Please use the following as a guide when evaluating the applications.

• 5-Outstanding:

All of the applicant's application materials exemplify superior or exceptional characteristics that contributes to the specific criterion.

• 4-Excellent:

The applicant's application materials illustrate extremely strong, but not exceptional, characteristics contributing to the standard. The reviewer may have a reservation, but there are redeeming features to compensate for or outweigh the reservation.

• 3-Strong:

The applicant's application materials demonstrate strong characteristics; however, the reviewer may have reservations.

• 2-Average:

While the applicant's application materials are satisfactory, the reviewer may have major reservations. Certain evaluation characteristics related to the criterion are not present.

• 1-Below Average:

The applicant's application lacks certain requested materials. The materials present are not satisfactory.

• 0-Weak:

The applicant's application is considerably incomplete with inadequate materials present.
