

OUR HISTORY

The last remaining building from the first and only African-American 4-H Club in Georgia, the Emery Thomas Auditorium is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.


First established in 1939, the camp provided a place for African-American 4-H youth to perform demonstration events, hold state congresses, and recreation prior to integration. The auditorium was built in 1957 as an assembly hall for the Dublin 4-H Center.


The auditorium is named for one of Dublin's first African-American City Councilman, Emery Thomas, who was integral to the camp's success. Today, the building is situated within the City of Dublin's Riverview Golf Course, and was renovated in 2024.
