Fire watch personnel must perform continuous tours such that each room in their assigned area is checked at not less than 60-minute									
intervals. The first entry in this log must be made within 60 minutes of the start of the fire watch and every 60 minutes thereafter. Times must									
be recorded using the 24-hour clock and initialed. Any problems found during the fire watch must be documented (along with the time found									
and initialed) and reported to the head of maintenance for immediate correction.
