## RESOLUTION #24-14

## A RESOLUTION BY AND THROUGH THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA TO GIVE LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION BY WOMEN IN NEED OF GOD'S SHELTER "WINGS" TO THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS ("DCA") FOR THE 2024 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT PROGRAM ("ESG"); TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs provides grant funds to emergency shelters through its Emergency Solutions Grants Program (ESG); and

WHEREAS, the non-profit Women in Need of God's Shelter (WINGS) desires to apply for grant funding for its operations and services as an emergency shelter for women; and

WHEREAS, non-profits are required to obtain local government approval for the application prior to submission of the application for ESG funding; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find that WINGS provides a service which is beneficial to the residents of the City of Dublin and Laurens County and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it will be in the best interest of the citizens of Dublin for WINGS to be able to continue their operations as an emergency shelter and that they should be able to apply for the grant funding through ESG; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wish to give their support and approval for the application to DCA for the grant funds and the City will have no pecuniary obligation or otherwise be bound by the terms of the ESG Grant.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA as follows:

That the Mayor and Council give their support and approval to WINGS to apply for grant funding through DCA's ESG program and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and execute any and all documents necessary to affect the purpose of this Resolution; and that this resolution shall have immediate effect upon approval by the Mayor and Council.
