A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO AUTHORIZE THE AWARD OF A BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION OF THE SANITATION AND WATER CONSTRUCTION FACILITY ON TRUXTON STREET; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have previously determined the city-owned facility located on Truxton Street currently housing the water construction division and sanitation divisions of the Water Utility and Public Works, respectively, is in need of major renovation; and

WHEREAS, the City has properly advertised and solicited bids for the work of the same under Request for Bid #24-03-001, (the "Bid"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City has receive a bid from Paul S. Akins Company, Inc., ("Akins"), in the amount of \$3,547,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has reviewed the single bid with the contractor to identify cost-savings adjustments to the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wish to empower the City Manager to make final approval of the award of the bid; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City to proceed with the construction project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN that the City Manager is authorized to approve the award of the Bid to Akins subject to such conditions as may be deemed appropriate by him; that upon said approval, the Mayor and hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the documents and contract documents necessary to effect the same.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is authorized to approve such change orders during the term of the contract as may be deemed appropriate and necessary by him; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all actions of the City, its officers, staff, and employees in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the Agreement is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall have immediate effect upon its adoption.
