RESOLUTION #24-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL ESTABLISHING NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION RATES; TO AMEND ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION; AND TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, ownership of refuse and waste materials is vested in the City of Dublin;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council may from time to time modify the fees charged for residential and commercial garbage services and establish new fees by resolution;

WHEREAS, each resident and each commercial establishment shall be entitled to receive such garbage collection service as provided upon payment to the City of a garbage collection fee; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined a need to increase the garbage collection rates in order to keep up with the increase in cost of performing the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby establish and impose the following rates and regulations for garbage collection services provided by the City:

Section One: Roll Carts

- a. <u>Residential Customers</u> each residential property shall receive one (1) collection of (1) City provided roll cart per week for residential garbage for <u>\$29.00</u> per month. This service is required for every residence in the City of Dublin.
- b. <u>Commercial Customers</u> each establishment using City provided roll carts shall receive (1) collection of (1) pick up per week of one (1) City provided roll cart for \$39.95 per month.
- c. A second roll cart can be provided and garbage collected one (1) time per week with the second roll cart for a one-time fee of \$75.00 and an additional fee of \$18.00 for residential customers and \$20.00 for commercial customers per month.

Section Two: Dumpsters

a. Commercial and Industrial Establishments: For those commercial and industrial establishments using containers (dumpsters) provided by the Dublin Sanitation Department, the size of the container and the number of pick ups per week shall be determined by the Sanitation Superintendent based on the volume of refuse and the composition of refuse generated by the establishment; and

- b. Rates for City of Dublin issued dumpsters for pickup shall be determined based on the size of the container and the number of pick-ups per week consistent with the per cubic yard rate established herein;
- The City offers dumpsters in the size of four cubic yards, six cubic yard, and eight cubic yards;
- d. The rate for dumpster pickup shall be \$5.42 per cubic yard per collection
- e. The minimum charge on all containers shall be computed at a minimum number of collections of containers provided per week.

Section Three: Miscellaneous Bulk Trash Charges

- a. The City will provide bulk trash collection to residential customers at no additional charge to the charge found in Section One of this Resolution.
- b. For all commercial customers, the following items will be collected by the Sanitation Department of the City of Dublin for a fee. The rates listed below shall be paid by the customer for collection of every single item listed below. The prices listed below are per item:

c. The Superintendent of Sanitation may refuse collection of any item if he/she determines that the collection of the item is impractical or prohibitive given the City's resources.

Section Four: Loose Materials

- a. The City will provide pickup of loose materials for residential customers at no additional charge to the charge identified in Section One of this Resolution.
- b. For all commercial customers, the rates for loose materials shall be as provided herein. All material collected from not approved containers shall be charged at the rate of \$5.42 per cubic yard for volume, plus the cost of labor, which cost shall be determined by the Sanitation Superintendent based on the personnel and equipment involved and the time required to complete the task. The cost of any landfill fees will be added to these rates.

Section Five: Special Services

a. The Superintendent of Sanitation for the City of Dublin may provide special services to customers based on the need and the availability of personnel to complete the requested task. All special service collections shall be charged at the rate to be determined by the Sanitation Superintendent based on costs of the personnel and equipment involved and the time and mileage required to complete the task. Any landfill fees will be added to these rates.

Section Six: Effective Date

a. This Resolution and the rates provided herein shall become effective on July 1, 2024. The City Treasurer is hereby directed to ensure that for services provided on or after July 1, 2024, the rates provided herein are charged.

Section Seven: Conflicting Resolutions Amended

 a. Any Ordinance or Resolution of the City of Dublin in conflict with this Resolution are hereby amended as provided herein.
