

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO APPROVE THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO GARBUTT CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE HILBURN PARK DESIGN BUILD PROJECT AND PRITCHETT STREET PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE SAME; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City properly advertised a request for qualifications of design build firms for Project No. 001, Hilburn Park and Pritchett Street Park Renovations as defined in RFQ No. 24-1004-01, (the "RFQ"), (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Garbutt Construction Company ("Garbutt") has presented the City with their qualifications and fee proposal for said Project and the City Staff has evaluated and recommends Garbutt be awarded a contract for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the city to approve Garbutt as the Design Build Firm for this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL that upon approval and recommendation by the City Manager and City/Staff Attorney, as to its form, the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver an agreement satisfactory to them as may be appropriate for the performance of the work specified in the RFQ.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all actions of the City, its officers, and staff in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the Project and the purposes of this Resolution are hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed. Upon recommendation of the City Manager and the City/Staff Attorney, the Mayor is further authorized to execute any other document in furtherance of the purposes of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager may approve such modifications, change orders, or reduction or addition of services to the contract awarded herein as may be deemed appropriate and necessary by him and the mayor may execute and deliver the same upon said recommendation and approval by the City Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall have immediate effect upon its adoption.
